But what do we mean when we speak of intersectionality? And above all, what is it for? In this talk-debate the concept of intersectionality will be presented to try to clarify everything you would have liked to know and have not dared to ask until now. It will be based on its history to also understand its potential in praxis. The potential of intersectionality as a tool to reveal and address the unwanted effects of legislation and public policies that address inequalities in a fragmented manner will be emphasized. And a debate will be opened on how to make operational the intersectionality approach in the praxis of local administrations.
